Project Timeline Example and Template

Fall 2016 - Spring 2017:

- Determined thesis research topic;
- Completed introduction, literature review and methodology sections of thesis.
- Submitted a conceptual paper to the International Textile and Apparel Association Annual Meeting

Fall 2017

- Developed a survey instrument;
- Passed thesis proposal defense;
- Conducted pre-test of the survey instrument and finalized instrument usage.
- Presented the final conceptual paper at the 2017 International Textile and Apparel Association Annual Meeting

Spring 2018

- Collected survey data via wjx.com;
- Started data analysis
- Plan to submit a paper abstract to the International Textile and Apparel Association Annual Meeting

Summer 2018

- Plan to complete thesis;
- Plan to submit thesis for defense.
- Plan to submit finished research paper to a peer-reviewed journal.

Fall 2019

- Start the Individual Interdisciplinary Doctoral Program (IIDP) in AMDT
