## Agenda items

- Feedback on a couple of applications (Nazua)
  - Reviewed some applicants and am seeking out feedback from others. One application was rejected because the candidate applied for the presidency and did not apply with a running mate.
  - One VPLA candidate had their advisor chair signature but did not have their department chair signature. What should we do about that?
    - Joseph believes that since they did not get that second signature, they should be rejected.
    - Ajay brings up that department chairs are more for a formal element, but we can give them a grace period. Desmond brings up that this decision should be made by the election committee.
  - We received an application for a college of representative position, but they
    did not include the department. We have the signature and we know they
    come from CAS, but we are unsure if they are running for CAS or for the
    Graduate School.
    - Dr. Barry recommended contacting them to get some clarity.
- Ballot & Candidate Debate Slots (Nazua)
  - Nazua needs more clarity on how we should approach the debate. We have
     15 minutes for the President and VP and 10 minutes for VPLA. Each college

rep should get 3 to 5 minutes. However, we are not sure about asking questions.

- Desmond made the point that it will depend on the length of the meeting.
- Ajay brings up that if President and VP are running together, then they should answer the questions together.
- Piktochart subscription renewal by Feb 25
  - Based on our previous discussion, Ajay is proposing not renewing the subscription.
  - o Nazua: I make a motion to end our subscription to Piktochart subscription.
  - Sajjad: Second
    - Yes: 4

    - Abstain: 0
- Best College rep award strategy
  - Each college rep will nominate 2 people, which includes a self-nomination.
